Mercy Flights New Hangar and Operations Building

Medford, Oregon

A non-profit organization, Mercy Flights provides expert emergency and non-emergency medical care and transport at a reasonable cost. Based at the Medford Airport, Mercy Flights provides air and ground medical transport services for Jackson County. They have two fixed-wing aircraft, a helicopter, and a fleet of ground ambulances.

Started in 1949, Mercy Flights grew and expanded into a collection of hangars and an office building on the west side of the airport. Realizing that their growing operation needed larger and more-modern facilities, they decided to build a new hanger and operations building. The new 14,400-square-foot hangar is large enough for all three aircraft, as well as a maintenance shop for the ground ambulances. The new 4,750-square-foot facility was designed to accommodate all of Mercy Flights' operational needs.

Project deliverables were suitable for plan check submission, obtaining contractor bids, and construction. ArcSine was involved throughout all construction phases.
